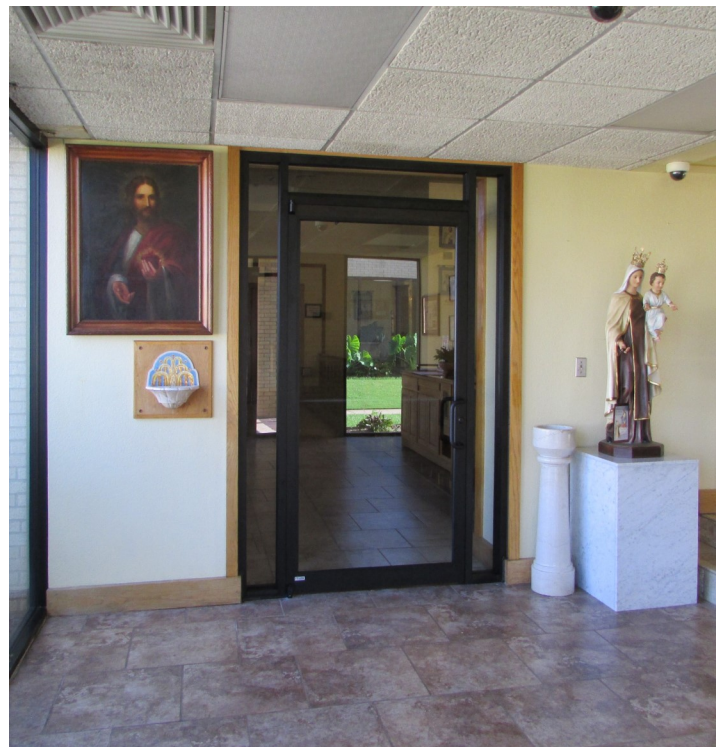


Message of the Week

Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Peter can declare with certainty that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the Living God, because of the way that his own life had changed since the first day that he met Jesus. The evidence for Peter's bold claim—his creed—is the fact that association with this man had brought a transformation of everything in his live, especially those things most resistant to change—the ordinary circumstances of life. Only God, with his “unsearchable ways,” could effect such a newness. The fact that Christ wants to use Peter as an instrument by which the Lord will open heaven to the world is surprising but not shocking. Jus as Peter has come to recognize God through the humanity of the man Jesus, God's method of self-communication will continue through the humanity of the Apostle Peter.
