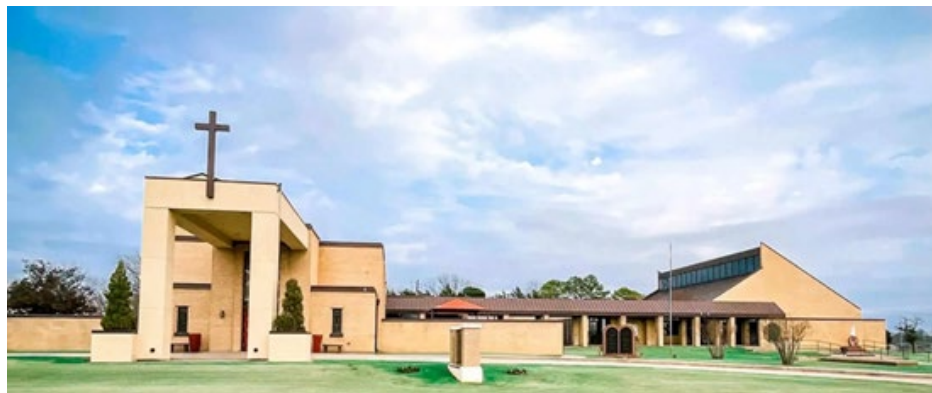

**November 1<sup>st</sup>** (Wed.) – HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION; **Mass: 9am**

**November 2<sup>nd</sup>** (Thu.) – We commemorate all souls of the faithful departed, especially our loved ones, family members, friends, and benefactors of the Shrine.
