Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today the Prophet Isaiah speaks to people steeped in anguish-those "in the darkness," stuck in "the gloom." His advice? "Share your bread with the hungry." His point: No matter how bleak our present state, the fact is, "you are the salt of the earth." In other words, despite crushing distress, we always have bread to bestow on the hungry. So, too, we are "the light of the world," and our "light shall break forth like the dawn" if we proact to "satisfy the afflicted." Then light shall rise for you in the darkness"; our wound "shall quickly be healed." Which is why we make our own Saint Paul's stunning resolve "to know nothing except Jesus Christ crucified." For actively sharing in the misery of others is the sure way out of our own.

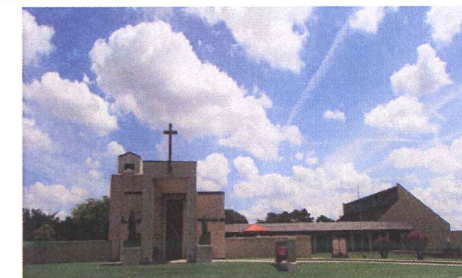
